Men & Boys

Acceptable Attire

- Golf shorts or similar walking or Bermuda shorts
- Golf shirts with a collar, turtleneck or mock turtleneck [Note: Shirts must be tucked inside shorts or slacks.]
- Golf shoes with soft spikes or sneakers
- Hats or visors with bill forward

Unacceptable Attire

- Running, biking or camp shorts; exercise or other athletic shorts; cut-offs or cargo shorts; carpenter pants; overalls
- Tank tops, tee shirts, or fishnet/mesh tops
- Swimwear or tennis attire
- Jeans and denim attire of all types and colors
- Clothing with inappropriate language or graphics
- Metal spikes of any types
- Hats or visors with bill to the side or backward

Women & Girls

Acceptable Attire

- Golf shorts or similar walking or Bermuda shorts; skorts or golf skirts of modest length; slacks, Capri, or crop pants
- Sleeveless, short-sleeved or long-sleeved shirts designed for golf, with or without a collar – including standard collars, boat neck, v-neck, turtleneck or mock turtleneck. [Note: Top/blouse styles meant to be worn outside the pants are acceptable if the overall appearance is neat.]
- Sweaters, jackets, golf jackets, vests and pullovers
- Golf shoes with soft spikes or sneakers
- Hats or visors with bill forward.

Unacceptable Attire

- Running, biking or camp shorts; exercise or other athletic shorts; cut-offs or cargo shorts; spandex shorts; carpenter pants; overalls
- Tank tops, racer back shirts, halter tops, tube tops, tee shirt; spaghetti strap, low-cut or mesh shirts
- Swimwear, tennis attire
- Jeans and denim attire of all types and colors
- Clothing with inappropriate language or graphics
- Metal spikes of any types
- Hats or visors with bill to the side or backward
