2 Hole Juniors:	Clinic from 10:00-10:30	Play begins at 10:30

Rules and Regulations:

- Charge is \$100 per child attending (max of \$150 per family). Price based on entire summer.
- Participants must be children or grandchildren of family golf members.
Grandchildren price (\$150/junior)
- The golf shop reserves the right to place juniors in the proper category
- Children 5 to 18 years of age are eligible. 18-year old's not in college are eligible.
- Juniors must be 5 years of age by June 23rd to participate
- 18 Hole juniors will be required to maintain a GHIN Handicap. 9 Hole juniors who play on a regular basis are also encouraged to main a GHIN Handicap. There is no charge.
- All juniors must turn in their score cards immediately upon completion of play. The golf staff and junior golf committee will score the events and post the results online.
- 2, 4, 6-hole groups **must be accompanied by an adult.**
Parents must volunteer their time at least twice during the season.
- All juniors must abide by the ERCC Dress Code (located on golf page of website)
- Proper conduct must be maintained in the clinics and on course
